

I bought this for teenage boys who need coping skills to manage anxiety. The designs in this book are good, complicated enough for older teens and adults, the only downside is the photos on the front of the book are of young kids who look kinda goofy, so it was hard to 'sell' to the boys. Without the cover it would be great!

I had been relying on YouTube videos for various techniques so I was worried about this medium. However, the illustrations and descriptions are very easy to follow. There are ideas to make many items, not just bracelets.

I remember making these when I was in high school I bought this for my 7,6,5 year old granddaughters. We made one for each of them and they loved doing it. Hope other grandmas or pas who know how to tie the knots do these with their grand kids it was fun!

I loved the designs and ease of construction of the bracelets. My grand daughter wants to learn to

make friendship bracelets too. The simple instructions will allow me to learn and teach with ease.

This is a great book for beginners, but anyone at a higher level than that will be a bit disappointed. The diagrams were super easy to follow, and it was really simple to figuring things out. Give yourself a couple chances, though- I definitely screwed up my first few attempts on some bracelets. After I learned all the bracelets in this book, I wanted to learn more patterns, so I searched around a bit and found a couple good websites. The basic skills in the front of the book make it easy to figure out literally any friendship bracelet pattern.

I bought this for my granddaughter. It had all the basics for anyone getting started making friendship bracelets. It is full of color pictures and great for the beginner.

I agree with the other reviewer that it needs a visual update. It seems like it's trying to be sold to conservative mom's for the kid's in their Bible study group or something...or at least that these pics were taken in the 90's. At least there's a boy on the cover, I suppose. As for the content...I found the Klutz book to be far more informative for teaching how to do the knots, though at first glance at the store, it seemed like the pictures in this one would be pretty good. I was happy to see new designs that weren't in the Klutz manual, but there is a design I'm trying to do that's a variation on one I already know, that seemed it would be EASIER, that I just can't figure out! I had read the instructions and thought I understood, but when I tried to start the bracelet it didn't make sense to me. Again, referring back to the Klutz manual, this book doesn't show where each string would lay over the other in the instructions. I'm going to try to find guides and videos online, but it's disappointing to not be able to just take the book and my strings and go. I'm hoping it's me and not the book, because there are some cool designs in here that I want to learn.

This is a great beginners book for anyone that has kids that might be interested in crafting bracelets. the instructions are really easy to follow.
