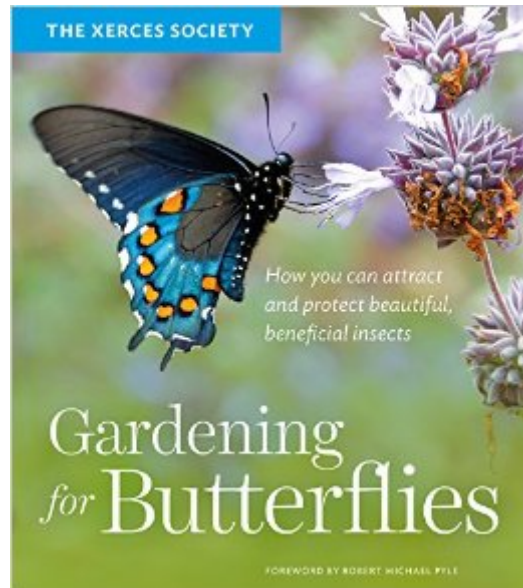

I got this book as part of my research for a neighborhood project called Pollinator Parkways. I found it very useful in regards to plant selection as well as other needs for butterflies (and moths!), thinking about their lifecycle as a whole. Fascinating and strange little facts puncture the book - carnivorous caterpillars worshiped by ants, for example. Big gorgeous photos, some elementary butterfly classification. I finished it in about 2 days.

Hands down the BEST guide to gardening for butterflies, and even other pollinators. Real, science-based information on garden design and pollinator habits. No one should be without this book if they're serious about making a difference in their landscape.

A great book for beginners or experts. It has outstanding photos and goes into detail about what each plant offers for butterflies, moths and caterpillars (you cant have the first 2 without the latter!)
