

This dictionary of stitches is a real standout. I have the DK book by Ganderton and gave that good marks but as time marches on improvements happen. This one is good because unlike Ganderton's book Gardner has some projects in it and of course the binder format makes it very easy to view and use. Interestingly, some of her methods are different than I have learned or what Ganderton shows and often makes a different look. It's an interesting foray from that side also.

'nuf said! I have had several embroidery instruction books in the past and none can compare to this book and series. Every step is clearly illustrated and easy to follow. Even the "complicated" stitches were very easy to complete. Buy this book if you are a beginner or want to clean up your existing stitches, it's fantastic!

This book has so many different stitches. They are clearly illustrated, step by step. I highly recommend it. The pictures are quality color. Australians are so excellent at handwork. This is a treasure reference I go to often.

I was looking forward to receiving my "new" embroidery book but when I opened the packet the majority of the pages were upside down!!
