

As one reviewer pointed out, much of the information can be obtained on the internet for free.

This little booklet is very helpful. It tells a tiny history, gives latin name, how to propagate, & how to harvest. They make a couple of use suggestions for each herb. Not too good on how difficult it can be to start some of them from seed. For the price, it is a nice introduction to the world of culinary herbs.

As a result of this little booklet, we now have a very nice herb garden in the back yard. You do need to experiment with your herbs, however, to find out which do the best in your own location. I find that if you aren't sure, you can plant some in pots and move them around to see where they do best.
