

Of special note are the pages set aside for the personalized addition of photos of the pet being memorialized. "Paw Prints In The Stars" is an ideal gift for anyone who has suffered the loss of a animal companion and wishes to honor their furry friend with a memorial keepsake.

I lost my beloved Lucky this past January. He was almost 11 years old. Since January, I have purchased so many different books on the loss of dogs, the grieving over dogs, etc., but had nothing really to memorialize him in writing. Until Paw Prints in the Stars. I started filling out the pages, including photos, the day I received my copy. Yes, I cried through the process; but it helped me so

much to just remember his life with me, and how much we loved each other. To anyone who has lost a much loved pet, this book is a must to help you through the grieving process. I highly recommend it for children who have experienced, for the first time especially, the loss of a loved companion.

I have been familiar with author Warren Hanson's works for several years, now, and his book Paw Prints in the Stars is a touching work of the loss/death of a pet. Warren has been gifted with the ability to construct exceedingly meaningful sentences and can create mental imagery like the master he is! Warren Hanson also illustrates his own books, and is a very talented artist/writer. I can certainly recommend this book, and it is a comforting reading upon the loss of or the pending loss of a beloved pet.

Why anyone would feel this is a child's book is beyond me. I can't express how much this book has helped me. I was a mess when my 19 year old Dachshund passed and didn't think anything would help me! My Mom bought me this book but I didn't read it for days thinking it would make me cry even more. Much to my surprise when I did read it it brought me great comfort! I have read it many more times whenever I am very sad about loosing him. It makes me think more about all that we did together over 19 years than just about having to make the decision to put him down.

This is not a long book. I read it in 5 minutes. It took that long because I was crying. However, of all the books I've read after I lost my sweet dog, this one helped me the most. I keep remembering one paragraph that I constantly repeat to myself whenever I start to cry about her, "I'm somewhere beyond the heavens where I can run and play forever. If I can't be with you, this is where I want to be." This may sound silly, but it's the only thing that helps me. I'm very glad I found this book.

This is such a wonderful little book that I have given it twice as a gift. It is a wonderful rememberance of 10 dogs I have in the Pet Cemetery - all older rescue dachshunds. There is room for photos and everything.

This book is wonderful and is helping me get through one of the hardest, saddest times in my life..

The poem in it is so sweet and touching. I love that is has pages for you to write your thoughts and put photos, I am so glad I purchased this and I will purchase it for friends that lose a beloved Furry child. Rest in Peace my little Quila....
